The role involves assisting multiple campuses across a region to deliver safe, fun, creative and engaging recreation and engagement activities for students at Alta-1 College.

You will have a demonstrated ability to deliver safe and engaging adventure-based learning activities in line with performance objectives and trauma informed practice in a secondary school age educational context. Delivery methods are required to follow Department of Education safety standards and trauma informed practice.

You are comfortable with collaboration and enjoy engaging with the students, parents, staff and other team members in the student's support team. You can work with the staff to develop the skills and confidence needed for them to run their own activities. You are physically fit and capable of running outdoor educational activities, including lifting and loading trailers.

Your calm and engaging nature will help you bring physical activity and adventure-based learning to life to disengaged students and you will provide advice and support to both the students and the staff members. You are a hands-on team member and proactive in solving problems with creative and positive solutions.

## Here's what you're responsible for:

The primary role of the Regional Activities Coordinator is to support the Alta-1 VET Projects Officer in the delivery of creative and high quality adventure-based learning activities. Your role will include, but may not be limited to, activities such as:

## SUPPORTING AND IMPROVING THE DELIVERY OF ADVENTURE BASED LEARNING ACROSS THE REGION

- Assist campuses to deliver outdoor adventure-based learning activities such as MTB / cycling, kayaking, canoeing, boating, swimming, snorkelling, fishing, hiking, light construction, horticulture and community service.
- Network with church partners and partnering community organisations to develop and deliver engagement programs such as Community Service Days, campus team building events and camps.
- Support staff with activity and program development including activity planning and approvals, Consent2Go proposals and planning, and developing risk assessments as per compliance requirements.
- Gain and maintain qualifications necessary to deliver activities, including kayaking, MTB, Aquatic Rescue, and others as per regional needs.
- Complete regular maintenance and safety checks on equipment. Record, report and repair any faults as needed.

- Train staff with the use of Consent2Go.
- Facilitate or assist with regional staff training days for skills compliance as required.

- Prepare program outlines, learning materials and risk assessments as required, including Consent2Go applications and approvals.
- Manage the College booking system to arrange for dispersal of resources as required.
- Keep and maintain student and campus participation records.

The role is 1.0 FTE and reports to the Program Manager VET.
